#### NOTE:

- i. **Seminars:** Every Doctoral Student is required to give four seminar presentations from First Year, Omega Semester to Third Year, Alpha Semester.
- ii. **Prospectus Development Stages:** The development of prospectus typically involves the following four stages: (1) *Conceptualization stage* (2) *Planning and research stage* (3) *Content development and design stage* (4) *Production and distribution stage*.
- iii. **Research Languages:** Based on your area of specialisation, you are required to enrol for any of the two research languages. *One modern/local language (Latin or Yoruba or Spanish or German or French)* and *one Biblical language, Biblical Hebrew or Biblical Greek*. However, you can decide to go with two biblical languages or two modern/local languages of your choice.
- iv. **Colloquia:** At Doctoral candidature, you are required to present two colloquia in your Third Year (Alpha and Omega Semesters).
